- Nicholas Wright, Licensed Professional Counselor, Wright Group Counseling
  - Weekly online group schedule (includes parent support group, men's group, anger management group.)
  - Please consider <u>Donating</u> to our <u>'Pay it Forward Fund'</u> to help those who can't afford counseling.

    - Male suicide, especially African American males is high. Also first responders

  - Clinicians of Color Network
  - Don't let finances be a barrier- has a few resources to bridge gap
- Charlsie Stratton Program Supervisor, Community Attention Foster Families
  - Program thru Dept Human Services, recruit and approve fosters families-Cville/Albemarle/Green Social Services
    - Big thing CAFF does that is unique/leading state- big on kinship familiesauntie/grandma, try hard to connect so kids placed with people they know/familiar to mitigate foster care trauma
    - Recruiting for families to support older youth and LGBTQ+ community- uptick in older kids in mental health crisis- need help for even short term stays...
      - Foster Care Awareness Month
        - Mac McClellan- 21st- work specifically providing kids of color with books that reflect them
- John Thompson, Family Service Specialist, DHS /Community Attention Community Based Services & Co-Founder of How U?A Black MENtal Health Podcast
  - Pandemic was extra hard found a way to bring black men from many different professions to the table to share about mental health...
    - Talked about stigma of talking about mental health
  - Revamping podcast and more raw- couldn't say everything last round
- Keshia Washington, Wildrock's Extraordinary Ebony Explorers program
  - Name shorted to Triple E- ages 6-10
    - A free Saturday field trip program for Black youth.
    - Transportation and lunch is provided
  - Tough for black children to play without folks subconsciously thinking things will happen and observant of what the child is doing- goal for libratory play- and for kids to develop social emotional skills.
  - Hire black youth- dev leadership skills and discuss college/mentor.
  - Raise awareness in the community show there is a problem and when go to parks let kids yell/have freedom. Kids are ok.
  - Funding extended through October. Looking to serve more black children. Need to reach more and get word out about the <u>summer/fall program</u>.
    - Donate
      - Important to kids to see community supporting
- Alex Weathersby, Shelter for Help in Emergency
  - SHE- survivors of domestic violence
    - Prevention- schools and community youth
      - Grant funded- free services
        - Counseling groups, health classes, Gay/Straight Alliances/club discussions, Healthy Relationships, Self care, Bullying
        - Summer School Program at one school talking about coping and healthy emotional skills- open to sessions at other schools..

- Teacher Appreciation Project Update- Heidi
  - <u>Teacher/Staff Appreciation | Families Helping Families | Charlottesville (albemarlefhf.org)</u>
    - Need great teachers and we realized inequities with parent volunteer time and supplemental funding
    - Honored over 1,000 educators, based on budget \$5/person
      - Wrote 7 checks to title 1 PTOs to support their activities
      - 50 handmade posters
      - Rallied over 100 volunteers
      - 100 donors- \$7300
        - Fund established for Fall with extra funds raised to continue to address inequities between schools - also \$1k from Rotary Club
    - Teacher Appreciation FAQ

            - Could invite rep from each feeder pattern reps from each elem/middle/high
